6-A-SIDE RULES

2010

Under 7's & u 8's

1. Due to FA rulings all under 7's & under 8's games are to be played on a non-competitive basis.
2. Teams will play games on a friendly basis. There will be NO league winner, semi-final or final
3. Teams will be split into Leagues but there will be NO points awarded for the games
4. There will be NO League tables kept or published
5. **All children will be awarded with a trophy for taking part.**

RULES OF PLAY

1. All teams will be made up of players who are within their respective age groups on 1st September 2009. Any team found playing with over age players will be disqualified.
2. Each team will consist of 6 players and 2 substitutes no more the 8 players per team.
3. A system of rolling substitutes will operate.
4. Players can only play for 1 team.
5. Each game will be 10 minutes straight. Apart from finals which will be 12 minutes straight

RULES OF THE GAME

1. All games will start with a drop ball.
2. Goal kicks to be taken from the goal line, except under 7's 8s who will take from the edge of the penalty area.
3. No passback's are allowed except for under 7's & under 8's. If this happens, then a direct free kick will be awarded.
4. The goal keeper can only handle the ball inside their penalty area.

5. If there is a foul in the penalty area, then a penalty will be awarded
6. There is no offside.
7. The first phase of the games will be played in groups on a league basis
8. If there is only one group, the top two teams will play each other
9. For two groups, the top two teams of each group will play each other in the semi-finals.
10. for three groups the top two will go in each league will go to the quarter finals and the best two placed third teams will go to the quarter finals.
11. The competition will be played as a league basis with 3 points for a win and 1 for a draw.
12. Should teams be level on points at the end of the league, then goal difference will be the deciding factor. If still level, the team which scored the highest number of goals will be adjudged the winner. If still level the teams will play each other, going to penalties and then sudden death.
13. Semi finals will be 10 minutes. If level after 10 minutes then extra time of 4 minutes will be played, if still level the game will be decided with penalties.
14. Finals will be 12 minutes, if level 4 minutes will be played, if still level the game will be decided with penalties.
15. Best of 3 penalties apply, followed by sudden death penalties.
Penalty taker has to be on the field of play at the end of full time.

DISCIPLINARY RULES

1. Any player sent off during play will miss the next game.
2. The referee will provide the match ball.
3. The referee's decision will be final on all matters during the game.
4. If you have a complaint please go to the control desk with a calm manner, the problem will be sorted out much quicker.
5. Any team failing to play a match at the appointed time shall forfeit the match with a
